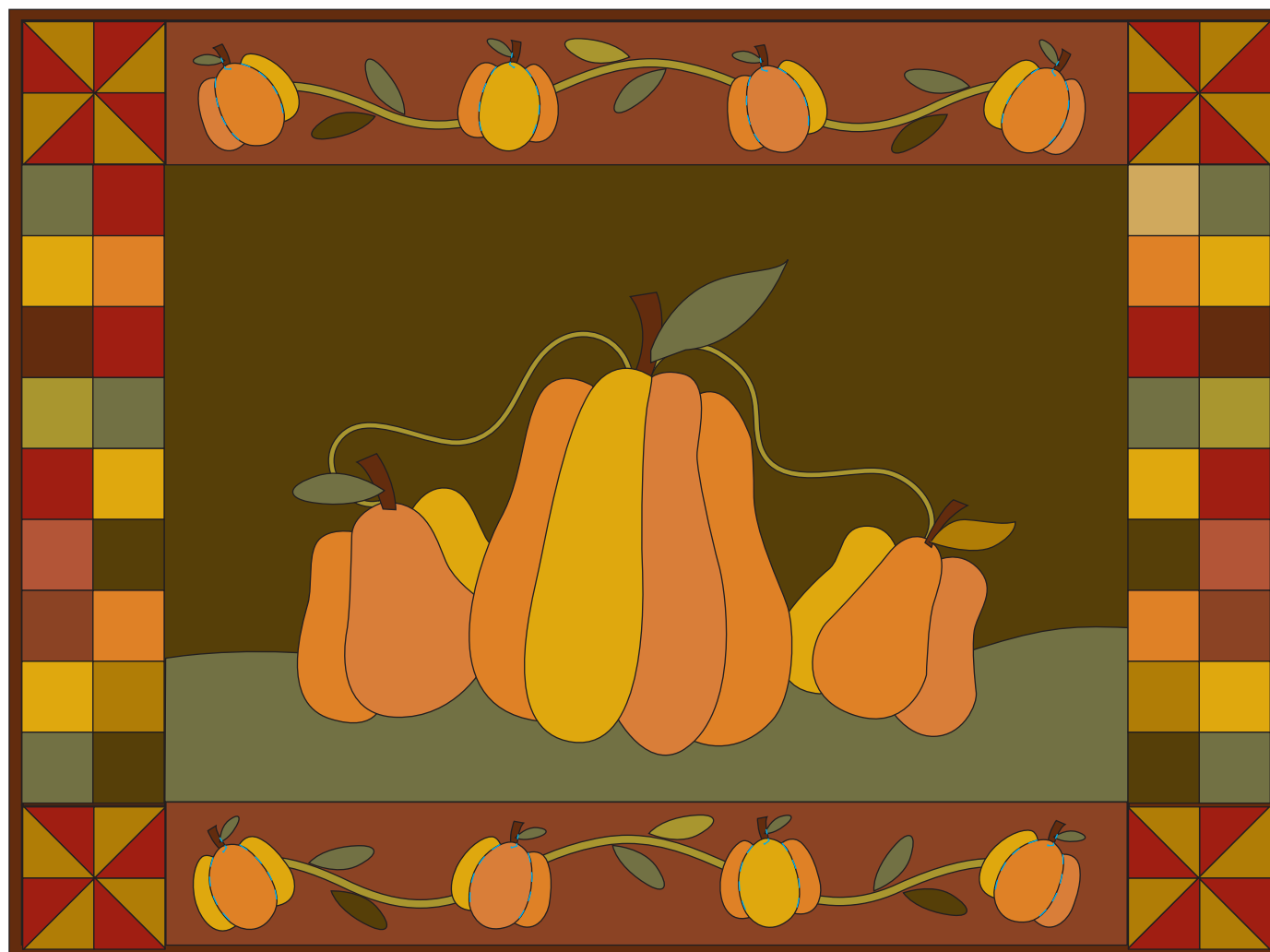


# ***"Pun'kin Patch Quilt"***

Finished size: 43.5 inches x 32.25 inches



## ***Finished dimensions:***

Quilt: 43.5x32.25

Pinwheel blocks: 5x5

"Two Patch" border blocks: 2.5x2.5

Applique punkin border: 33.5x5

Center punkin medallion: 33.5x22.25

**and** *Sew on*

# ***“Pun’kin Patch Quilt”***

**Finished size: 43.5 inches x 32.25 inches**

## ***Fabric Requirements (approximate):***

1 FQ dark orange

1 FQ red (*Pinwheel blocks and “Two Patch” squares*)

1 FQ medium brown

1 FQ taupe

1 FQ light gold

1/2 yard gold (*punkin pieces, Pinwheel blocks and “Two Patch” squares*)

1/2 yard medium green (*leaves, bias stems, lower background of applique*)

1 yard dark green (*leaves, bias stems, applique background*)

1 yard dark pink (*patch squares and horizontal borders*)

## ***Cutting:***

For applique center, cut one 34 x 22.75 inch rectangle out of medium green fabric.

For “ground” of applique panel (optional) cut one 34 x 10 inch rectangle. To simulate the curve, cut the top of the rectangle in a curve freehand.

Cut 36 “A’s” out of assorted fabrics for scrappy “Two Patch” vertical border.

Cut 16 “B’s” out of red print for Pinwheel blocks

Cut 16 “B’s” out of gold print for Pinwheel blocks

Out of remaining fabric, cut each applique pattern piece according to cover image

# ***“Pun’kin Patch Quilt”***

**Finished size: 43.5 inches x 32.25 inches**

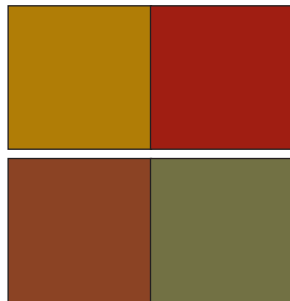
## ***“Two Patch” borders:***

- 1 Join 1 print “A” to another print “A” right sides together, using 1/4 inch seam allowance. Press seam open to reduce bulk. Please note that not all “As” will be either red or gold as in example.



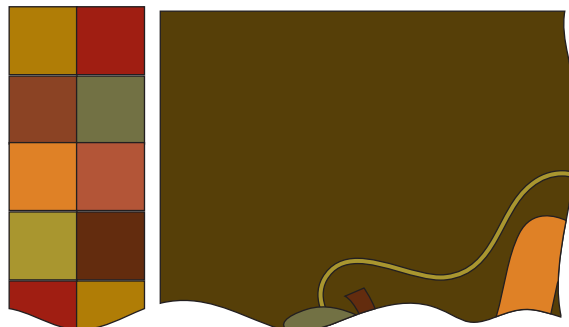
Make 18 “Two Patch” Units

- 2 Lay out 2 rows of “Two patches” and join as shown below. Then sew on another “Two Patch” unit. Repeat until you have 9 “rows” of “Two Patch” units. Repeat process to create other border unit.



Make 9 rows.

- 3 Sew border units to main appliqued panel, using 1/4 seam allowance. Press seam allowances open to reduce bulk.

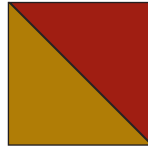


# ***“Pun’kin Patch Quilt”***

**Finished size: 43.5 inches x 32.25 inches**

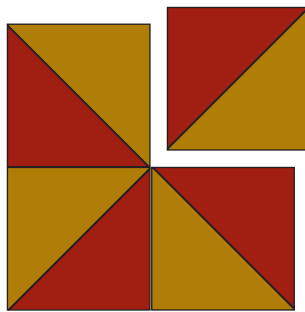
## ***Pinwheel blocks:***

- 1** Join 1 red print “B” and 1 gold print “B” to make a triangle square, using a 1/4 inch seam allowance. Make 16 triangle squares. Press each seam open (to reduce bulk).



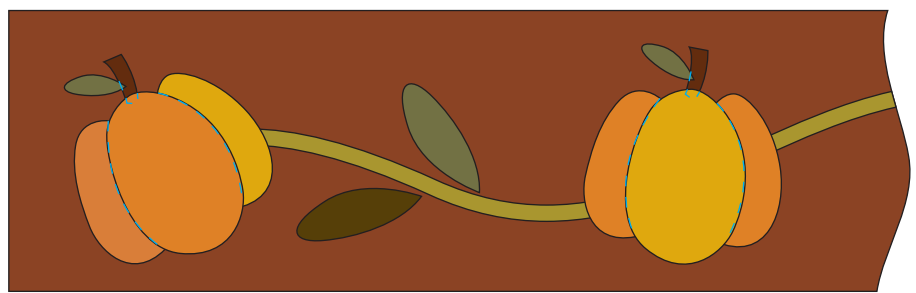
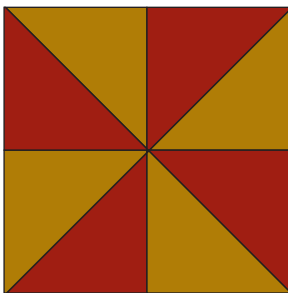
**Make 16**

- 2** Lay out 4 triangle squares as shown in below. Sew together to form one “Pinwheel” block. Repeat to make all four blocks.



**Make 4**

- 3** Sew completed “Pinwheel” blocks to horizontal appliqued borders using 1/4 inch seam allowance. Press seam allowances open to reduce bulk.

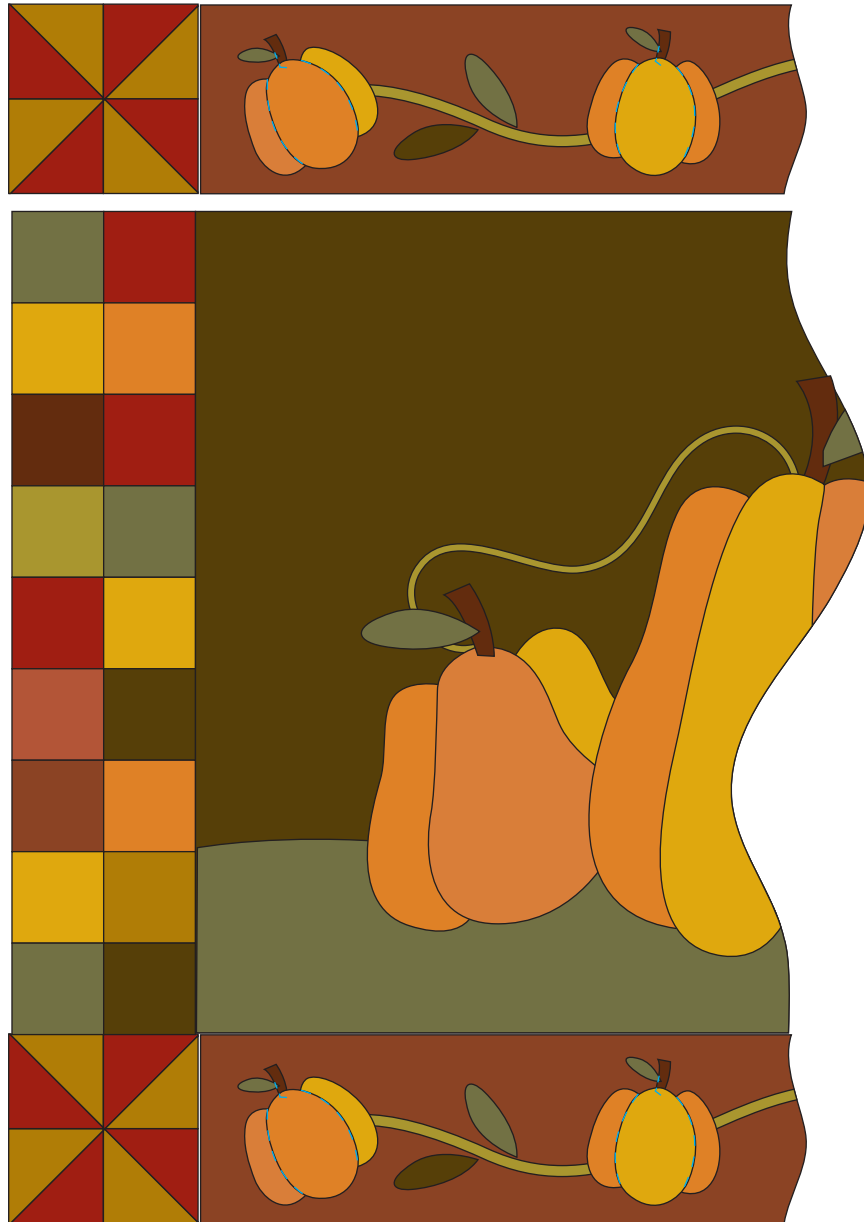


# ***"Pun'kin Patch Quilt"***

## ***Assemble the quilt:***

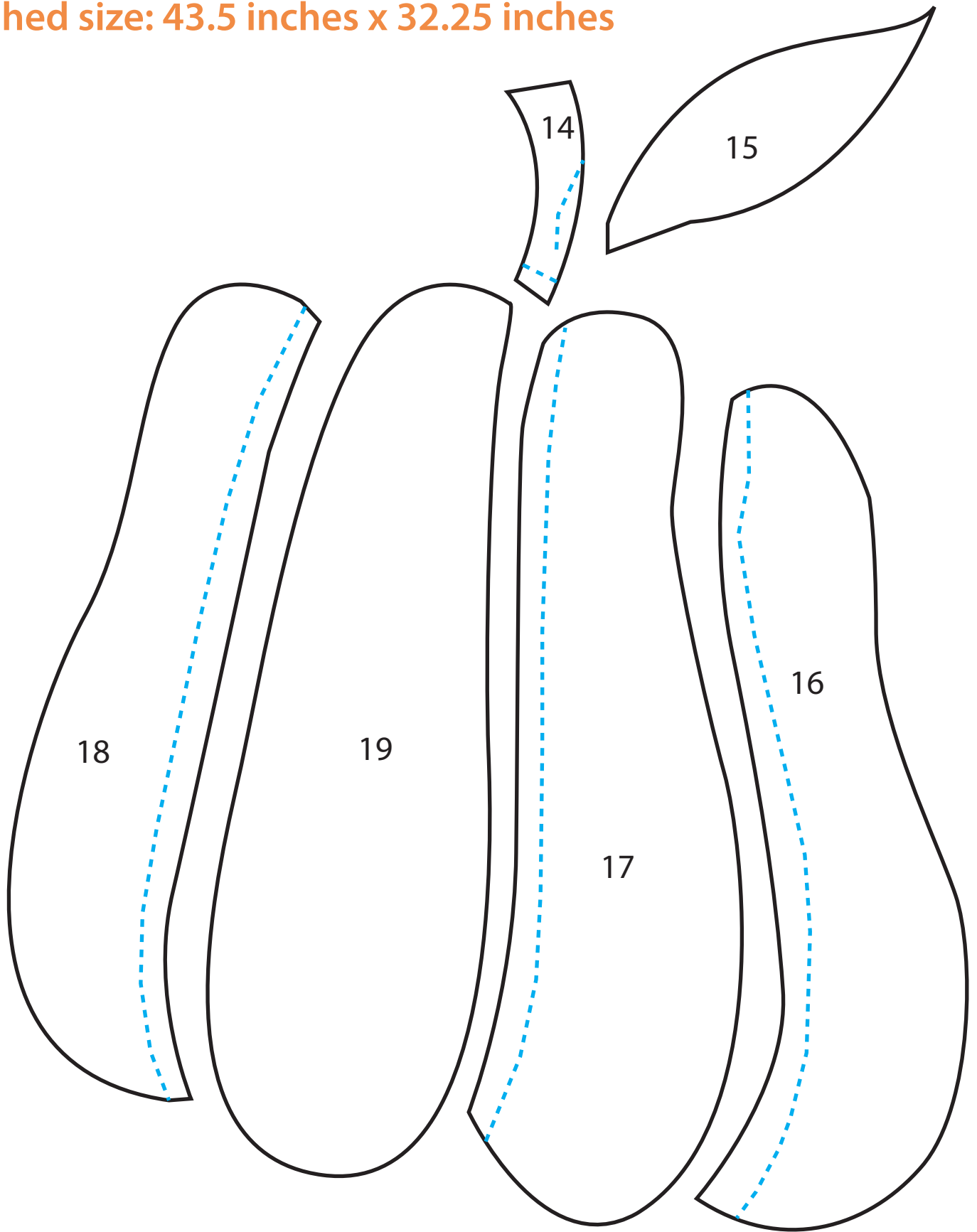
- 1 Join Pinwheel and border units to center applique and "Two Patch" border units.

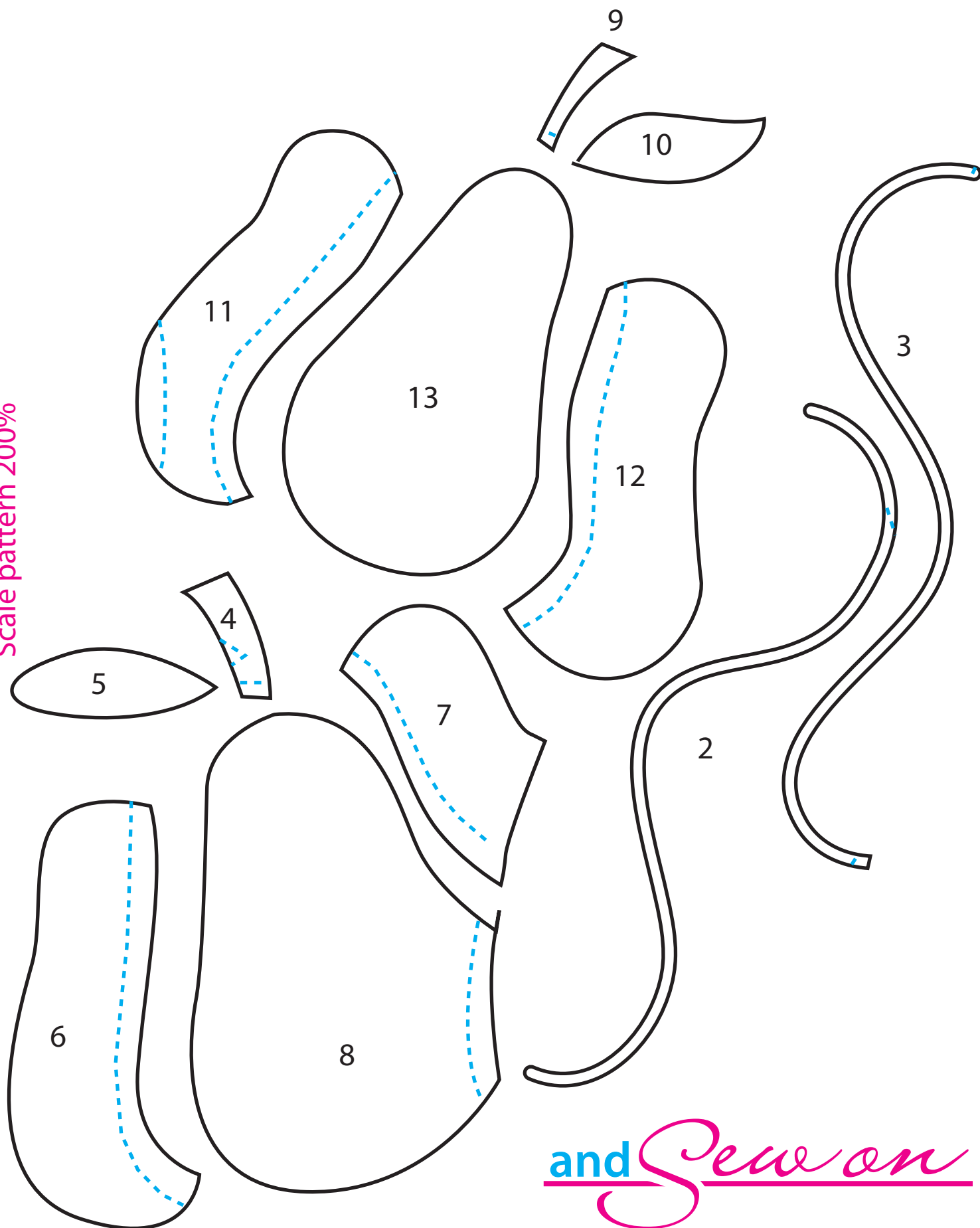
Scale pattern 200%

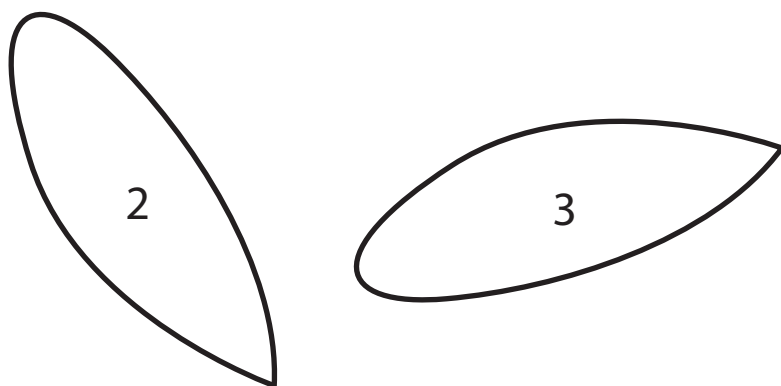

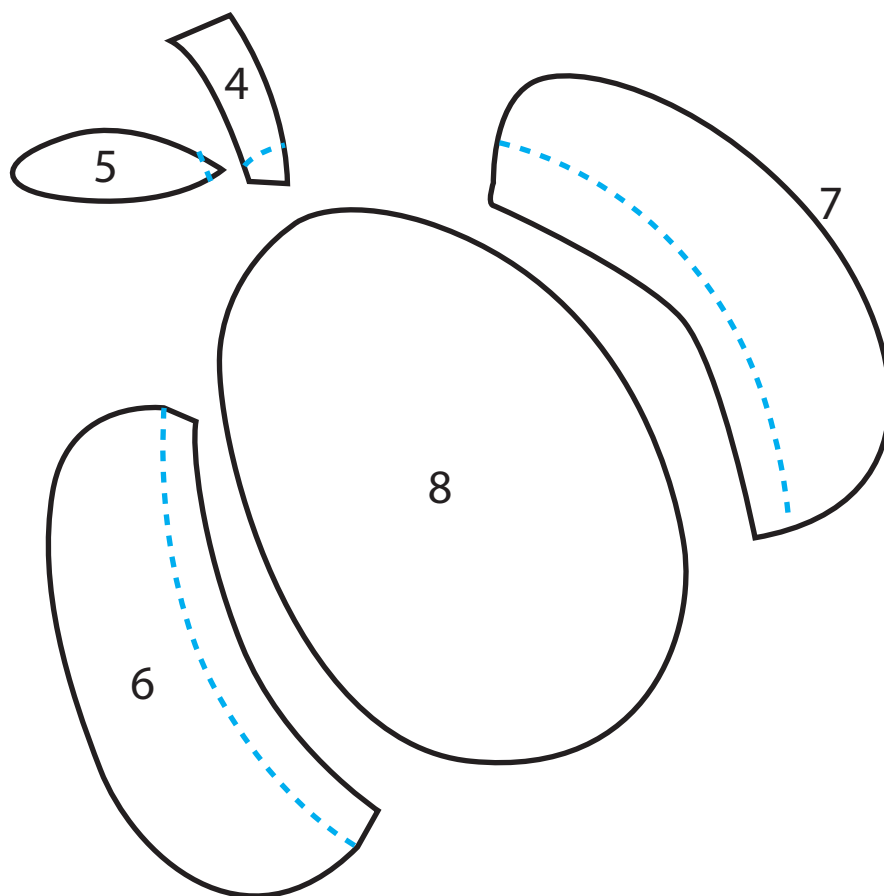
# "Pun'kin Patch Quilt"
